Prof Munns has published original research and consensus guidelines in the most influential and highest citing journals, including Lancet, Nature Reviews Endocrinology, Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism, Journal of Bone and Mineral Research, Bone, American Journal of Human Genetics, Journal of Child Neurology and PLoS. He has received \$3.5 million in competitive research grants, investigator-initiated research grants and philanthropic support for research, including 3 NHMRC Project Grants.

Prof Munns has been an invited speaker at over 100 national and international conferences, including Endocrine Society Annual Scientific Meeting (ENDO), American Society of Bone and Mineral Research (ASBMR), International Meeting of Pediatric Endocrinology and Asia Pacific Paediatric Endocrine Society. In 2015 was awarded Best Oral Communication at the 7th International Conference on Children's Bone Health, Salzburg, Austria.

He is chair of the Bone and Mineral Working Group of the Australasian Paediatric Endocrine Group (APEG) and the APPES Bone and Mineral Working Group. He is on the Executive of the Scientific Committee of International Conference on Children's Bone Health (ICCBH) and am leading its transformation into an international society. 2006 to 2018, was Honorary Treasurer of APPES.
