

Brief Autobiography:

Dr. Tony Tzu-Chun Wei is an attending physician at the Department of Urology of Taipei Veterans General Hospital and a MOE-certified lecturer at National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University, Taipei, Taiwan. Having obtained his MD from the National Yang-Ming University, he served at the Ma-Zu Military Hospital on the frontline across the Taiwan Strait for one year. Then he had his residency at the Department of Surgery and became the chief resident and clinical fellow of the Department of Urology at the Taipei Veterans General Hospital. After serving as an attending physician, he also obtained the PhD degree at the Institute of Clinical Medicine, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University in 2022.
